A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

If the limit is NOT reached by the closing date, day entries will be accepted up to one half hour prior to trial 1 time or when the courses have been posted, whichever comes first. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Trial Secretary. An alternate list will be kept in the order received, alternates may be allowed to run in the place of any absent dog. By entering this Trial, you are agreeing to the rules and regulations laid out in this Premium List. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which CKC rules will govern.

**Entry fees, per dog per event** (prices listed include HST)

Per Run: \$28.00      FFO: \$18.00      Exhibition Only (dogs not entered but on event grounds: \$13.00

TCN fee per dog per trial (charged by CKC) \$11.30 each trial. CKC charges a run entry fee of \$4.90 plus HST which is included in the fee.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible to compete in this trial, a dog must be at least 18 months of age, 12 months for sanctioned matches, may be spayed, neutered or debarked and registered with the CKC or eligible for registration with the CKC with a TCN, have an ERN, PEN, MCN or CCN. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in the trial. The dog must not be lame nor compete if it has tape or bandages.

**Venue Information:**

Indoors on packed sand. Ring size up to dimensions of 180 x 80 feet. Break away tire, rubberized contacts, free standing jumps, electronic timing. Wall Jump and Broad Jump are available (depending on judge's course design) (not in the Novice level or in J&T or Steeplechase).

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- 1) Competitors will be required to volunteer.
- 2) Entries MUST be accompanied with full payment to be accepted as valid.
- 3) Entries for minors under 18 must have the agreement signed by a parent or guardian.
- 4) No contact familiarization will be granted. One warm up jump will be available.

- 5) Keep barking to a minimum and keep your dogs on leash (except when competing) and under control at all times. No prong collars or flexi leashes are allowed on the Rolling Gait Canine Centre property.
- 6) This is a NON SMOKING facility.
- 7) No dogs are to be allowed to mark on or near the fencing enclosing the fields to the right of the arena. These fields will host competitions and everyone needs to develop the habits of leaving those fences clean. Likewise, do not allow your dog to mark on any part of the building, indoors and out, nor anything humans have to handle (ie. Garbage cans etc).
- 8) On leash woods walks are allowed during trial hours only.

**\*\*TCN – Temporary Competition Number** - MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCN's will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. TCN fees will not be refunded. This will then allow a dog who completes the requirements for Championship status to be moved up to "Specials"

**Move-up option:** Move Ups will not be allowed.

**Exhibitor Information:** Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the current CKC Agility Rules and Regulations. All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete: Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made – no refunds are given due to an error in entries. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. The club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.

**Refunds:** Refunds will be given ONLY in the following circumstances and as described below. (Any etransfer service charges WILL NOT be refunded.) Refunds will be etransferred to the exhibitor. Should you wish to withdraw your entry between the time that you submit your entries and when entries close you will receive a refund of 80% of your entry fees. A full refund will be given for bitches in season and medical reasons with veterinary note. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of Entry will be made.

**Waitlisted & Absent dogs:** Entry fees for an absent dog replaced by an alternate dog shall be refunded to the absent dog's owner. Alternate dogs not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded. Bitch in Season Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Agility, comes into season after the entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-days preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the starting date and time of the trial. The TCPC will refund entry, recording and TCN fees if the above conditions are met. A 80% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

**Injured Dogs** If a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured within the 3 days preceding the trial, must reach the Trial

Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The TCPC will be keeping 20% service fee and any TCN fees collected (if applicable).

No refunds: No refunds will be given for any difference in fees already paid if an exhibitor switches from a regular run to an FFO run at the trial. There will be no refund for dogs that are expelled because they have been deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian (except as written in this Premium List) or the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, strikes, Federal, Provincial or Local requirements or any other cause beyond the control of the Thames Centre Performance Club..

**Entry fee Information:** Entries will be accepted after the entry deadline if the trial has not filled with the following conditions: There will be no discount packages allowed; the price of each run will be \$28 Entry must be received 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial being entered. Additional classes added after closing to an existing entry will be processed at the exhibitor's previous discount, no further discounts will be applied. FFO (For Fun Only) Runs are NOT included in the discounted total run fee. CASH ONLY FOR POST CLOSING ENTRIES Payment is by etransfer only. NO entry will be accepted without payment in full.. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made..

**Volunteers:** Volunteering is necessary to run these trials, it is expected that everyone pitch in for classes they are not running. Sign up prompts are part of the online entry form. Courses cannot run until they are filled. The positions include the following:

3 Ring Crew: Setting poles, adjusting height on A-frame, one is needed to act as a leash runner moving the leash from the starting point to the exit gate. 1 Scribe: recording the judge's faults and scores during the dog's run – a cheat sheet of hand signals is provided. 1 Gate Steward: Calls out the running order of dogs, ensuring individuals get to the ring when appropriate, and calls out height changes for the ring crew. Course builders: build the course according to the judge's requirements. Volunteers in the ring must have their cell phones on silent. No food or drink except water.

### **Indignities**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**Equipment as follows:** Electronic timers will be utilized. Teeter and Walk are Galican with rubberized contacts. Pause table, A-frame set to 5'6 for dogs jumping 24' and 20', 5' for dogs jumping 16,12,8, and 4', Weave poles 24' spacing, Break away tire, Open tunnel, Bar jumps, Ascending spread jump, Panel jump, Double bar jump, and Triple bar jump, Wall jump, Broad jump. Cooling provisions for the dogs will be available.

### **General Class Information**

The following C.K.C. classes (divided by heights) will be offered:

**Standard Regular Class:** divided into these Levels

**Novice Standard:** Novice Class is open to any dog that has not earned a Qualifying score in the CKC Intermediate Class. This class is not divided. Novice is for dogs that have not acquired the Novice title and/or have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate.

**Intermediate Standard:** The Intermediate class is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent title.

**Excellent Standard:** The Excellent class is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title. **Master Excellent Standard:** The Master Excellent class is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent title.

### **Jumpers with Weaves(JWW)**

JWW has the same levels, heights, and conditions as for Standard Regular.

### **Jumps and Tunnels**

Jumps and Tunnels is a game that tests dog and handler ability to work on a course designed entirely of jumps and tunnels. It is intended to demonstrate the dog's ability to respond to handling while performing at speed.

**Ribbons:** Ribbons will be awarded to any dog receiving a sanctioned qualifying score. Placements ribbons will be offered for first, second, third and fourth in each height division. Ribbons are self-serve. New Title Ribbons: Not applicable in Sanctioned Matches

**Benching, Camping and Concessions:** Parking will be clearly marked out. Only park in designated areas, do not block roads or driving lanes. Parking is free and individuals may bench out of their vehicles. Benching is not permitted in any area other than the assigned spaces or your vehicle. Vehicles will be moved if parked in non-designated areas. Please do not park on the east side of Eaton Road and do not approach the horses. Dogs may not be left unattended in any outdoor enclosure. If animals left in vehicles are believed to be in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered, and the owner will be reported to the appropriate governing body. TCPC will not accept any responsibility for damage to any vehicle entered to remove an animal(s) in distress. Contact information must be posted on the outside of your benching area in the event of an emergency. All benching spaces must be vacated within one hour of the conclusion of the trial. All use of the property is at your own risk. All Benching areas must be cleaned before departure and left in the same condition as they were upon your arrival. Leaving a dirty benching space may result in denial of the privilege at future Shows or a ban from the facility. Potable water, dog cool down pool and portable washroom is available.

**Facility Information:** Rolling Gait Canine Centre is a dog exclusive facility located 15 min outside of London, Ontario. The property is easy to locate and backs on to the 401 with a few restaurants and gas available within a 5 min drive. Rolling Gait Canine Centre is listed on Google Maps with a pin to the location. The Agility arena is the first building on the right and visible from the road. Parking lot will be clearly identified with signage.. Water is available on site; the tap to the left of the entrance door along with the cool down pool. The water is potable, has been tested and is within safe limits for people and pets.

**CAMPING:** Limited overnight dry RV/Motorhome Parking is available for \$30 per night. Camping can be reserved through [dogshow.ca](http://dogshow.ca) entry form
