General Information

“It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred”.

Eligibility to Compete

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN, Eligible for registration with the CKC, or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed.

*See below for TCN numbers.

A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked. Dogs must not be lame or must not compete if tape or bandages may impair its working ability. Dogs with physical challenges are eligible to compete, if in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search.

Bitches in season

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete under CKC Rules. We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trials. This certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.

Levels Offered

Instinct, Novice, Open, Excellent and Masters (Containers, Interior and Exterior). Limited class entries. Exhibitors CANNOT compete in the same component at the same level with multiple dogs.

NO move ups will be permitted on the day of the trial.

NOTE: Instinct is an entry on its own or can be combined with Novice only. It cannot be combined with Open, Excellent or Masters levels.

Event Plan

The order of events will be as follows:

Masters – Containers/Exterior followed by Interior

Excellent – Containers/Exterior followed by Interior

Open – Containers/Interior followed by Exterior

Instinct

Novice – Containers/Interior followed by Exterior

Check in and start times will be determined after the trial closes.

Next Pup:

We will be using the Next Pup App at this trial. This app will allow you to track which dogs are running and hopefully help keep things running smoothly. It is not mandatory to use the app. Paper copies of the running orders will be posted as well.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

Non-member participation fee /TCN Number

The CKC requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

Please Read the Following Rules

1. No wet shoes allowed on the rubber flooring. Please bring a clean dry pair of indoor shoes
2. Dogs must always be on leash. No prong collars, choke collars or e-collars on the entire property. Dogs must be on a flat collar, martingale collar or flat harness only
3. Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces even if your dog is not aggressive. There is NO nose to nose contact at the school
4. Please clean up your dog's waste. Garbage cans will be available at the front door of the school
5. Please clean up after yourself.
6. No smoking anywhere on the trial site
7. Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum
8. Be kind to our judge(s) and volunteers. Remember, if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
